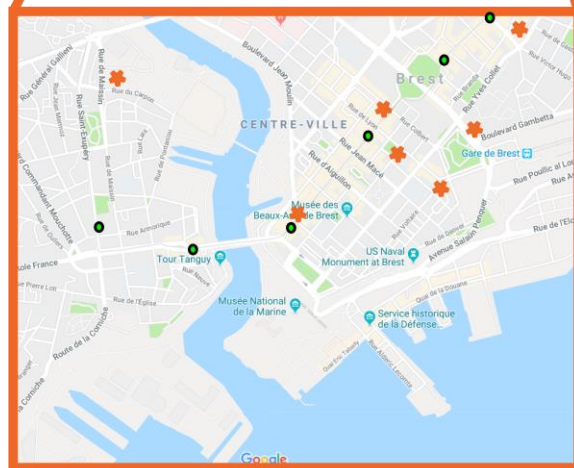
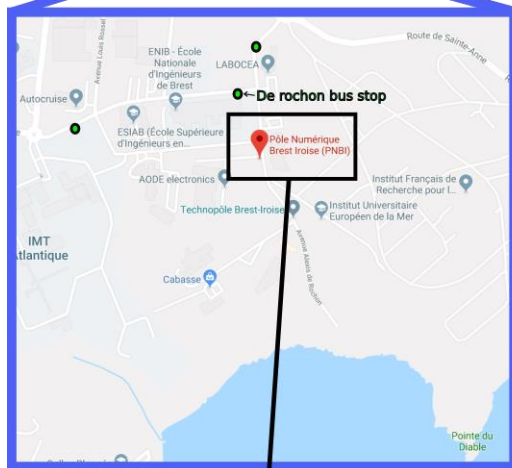

Accommodation in Brest

We recommend that you stay in Brest city center as it is where you will have public transport, shops, restaurants and bars. In Brest, we recommend that you stay in area close to a tram station to commute easily to the conference venue and the city center (and close to a Boulangerie, because you cannot start a day without a French croissant). The most convenient areas in Brest include 'Saint Martin', 'Siam', 'Recouvrance', 'Les Capucins'.

Airport to Brest city center

There are [regular shuttles](#) that make the connection between the Airport and the tramway that goes to Brest city center. It costs €1.60 one way (including the tramway leg, the ticket is valid for 1 hour).

Coming to the conference venue from Brest city center

The conference venue (near the IUEM) is about 8 km from Brest city center. You can come by car (carpooling can be a good option and we will organise something), otherwise, it is possible to reach the venue using public transport.

The easiest way is to catch the tramway A from the city center (stop "Liberté", or "Siam", or "Chateau") to the terminus station "Porte de Plouzané". Regular bus #13 connects the tram's terminus station to the Conference Venue. Stop at the station called *De Rochon*.

Line #43 is a direct line between the city center (stop 'Liberté') and the Conference Venue, however there are only 4 trips scheduled a day. ([2 trips that arrive at the conference venue](#) at 8am and 9am, and [2 trips that leave the conference venue](#) at 5.15pm and 5.45pm).
